Half Termly Learning Overview for Autumn Term 1 2022

<p>Our key texts in English this half term are: The Three Little Pigs, Jack and the Beanstalk, Chicken Licken, The Town Mouse and Country Mouse, The Magic Porridge Pot and The Enormous Turnip.</p> <p>Children will continue to learn and practise new phonic sounds based on the Read Write Inc programme. In English, we will be using our understanding of the key texts to write traditional tales using full stops and capital letters in our sentences.</p>	<p>Children will consolidate their knowledge of place value within 10. They will learn to count to and across numbers to 10 and then 20, counting forwards and backwards, beginning with zero or 1, and from any given number. They will identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations. Children will also learn how to use a number line, and use mathematical language including: equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most and least.</p>	<p>Children will be learning about everyday materials. They will recognise and label different materials, such as wood, plastic, glass, paper, fabric, rock, metal and water. They will also discover the difference between objects and materials and explore some of the simple properties of different materials. Through investigation, they will discover other properties of materials for example: whether materials are waterproof, transparent, opaque or absorbent and find out why certain materials are chosen for certain objects.</p>	<p>In PSHE, the children will focus on 'Being Me in my World' and learning about how we build our class and school community. They will understand the rights and responsibilities as a member of a class and that their views are important, they will learn that their choices have consequences and understand their own rights and responsibilities with their classroom.</p>

<p>Children will be looking at a range of songs and learning about timbre, structure and rhyme.</p>	<p>Children will be learning about significant historical events, people and places in their own locality. They will be finding out about the local area and answering why Bentley Heath school was built on Widney Road? They will also explore the impact of the work of John Cadbury in Bournville and the achievements of William Shakespeare.</p>	<p>Children will explore mark-making and line; working and experiment different materials through observational and collaborative pieces. Their learning will be centred around the artists Zaria Forman and Yayoi Kusama.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Read to your child every night ✓ Hear your child read and support their use of phonics to 'Fred talk' unknown words. ✓ Use Purple Mash at home with your child. ✓ Ask children about their learning each day, discussing their successes and challenges. ✓ Listen to songs together and discuss rhyme and pulse. Can they clap out a song? ✓ Use the links on the homework each week to practise their phonics sounds. ✓ Chant and practise number bonds to 10 and 20. ✓ Continue to access the White Rose App for games to support mental maths. ✓ Read and discuss traditional tales.
